Re: City Council Bill 15-0473 - Rezoning – 31-35 North Fulton Avenue

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0473, for the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 31-35 North Fulton Avenue from the R-9 Zoning District to the B-2-2 Zoning District.

If enacted, this bill, which is a companion bill to City Council Bill 15-0472 (Urban Renewal-Franklin Square-Amendment), would change the zoning to support the conversion of a vacant church building to a community health clinic. Bon Secours Baltimore Health Corporation has plans to purchase the vacant church building and convert it into a facility that would provide basic health and dental services for the community.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the passage of City Council Bill 15-0473.
