At its regular meeting of April 14, 2015, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation considered City Council Bill #15-0497, for the purpose amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Jonestown to add a new disposition lot to the Renewal Plan, to revise Exhibit 1 to reflect a land use change in a portion of the new disposition lot, and to revise Exhibit 3 to reflect the addition of the new disposition lot; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

In its consideration of this Bill, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation reviewed the attached staff report which recommended that CHAP has no objection to the amendment and defers to Planning regarding zoning for City Council Bill #15-0497 (10 members being present and 10 in favor).
