Re: City Council Bill 14-0430 – Sale of Property – 3314-3318 Ayrdale

Avenue

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 14-0430, for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 3314-3318 Ayrdale Avenue (Block 2900, Lot 009) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

If this bill is enacted, it would authorize the sale of a vacant commercial structure that is no longer needed for public use. The property is located in the Forest Park Neighborhood and is approximately 3,900 square feet. A developer has expressed interest in purchasing the property for either a barber shop or beauty salon.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 14-0430.
