**PARKING**  
OF BALTIMORE CITY  
**AUTHORITY**

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 15 - 0526 introduced by Councilmember Middleton at the request of Calvary Baptist Church of Baltimore, Maryland.

The purpose of this bill is to permit, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking open - off street area on the property known as 4001 - 4005 Garrison Blvd as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. reviewed the proposed legislation and determined that there would be no negative impact to any parking in the area resulting from this bill's passage. The City of Baltimore Zoning Commission will require the owners of said property to comply with the current parking ratios as directed by the Code in addition to meeting federal guidelines established by the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) for handicapped parking.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 15 - 0526.
