Re: City Council Bill 15--0476 - Zoning - Conditional Use Conversion of a 1-Family Dwelling Unit to a 2-Family Dwelling Unit in the R-7 Zoning

District – 2515 Brookfield Avenue

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0476, for the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the conversion of a 1-family dwelling unit to a 2-family dwelling unit in the R-7 Zoning District on the property known as 2515 Brookfield Avenue.

If enacted, this bill would allow for the renovation of a blighted property in the Reservoir Hill national Register Historic District from a single family dwelling unit to a two family dwelling unit. The proposed use as a two family dwelling unit is consistent with other dwellings in the neighborhood and would enable the constructive re-use of a vacant structure.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 15-0476.
