Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0520 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would allow the City to sell all, or a portion of, its interest in the alleys and portions of streets and alleys located behind Brentwood Avenue, declaring them no longer needed for public use.

Section 5(b) of Article V of the City Charter grants the Department of Real Estate in the Comptroller's Office the power to sell property that the Mayor and City Council deems by ordinance no longer needed for public use, if that sale is approved by the Board of Estimates. This is the appropriate ordinance. Therefore, the Law Department approves the bill for form and legal sufficiency.
