A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –**  
3 **Department of Transportation – \$6,500,000**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the  
5 amount of \$6,500,000 to the Department of Transportation – Service 688 (Snow and Ice  
6 Control), to provide funding for additional operating expenses incurred for the response to  
7 winter weather events; and providing for a special effective date.

9 Article VI - Board of Estimates

13 **Recitals**

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from Income Tax Revenue in  
15 excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to  
16 balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2015.

17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of  
18 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2015 was formulated.

19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the  
20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2015 was formulated or is for a new program that could  
21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

22 On May 27, 2015, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City  
23 Council.

24 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
25 \$6,500,000 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation – Service 688 (Snow  
26 and Ice Control) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year

1 2015, to provide funding for additional operating expenses incurred for the response to winter  
2 weather events. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from Income Tax Revenue  
3 in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in  
4 determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2015.

5 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is  
6 enacted.
