The Department of Transportation (DOT) is pleased to herein report on City Council Bill #15-0526 / Zoning – Conditional Use Parking, Open Off-Street Area – 4001 – 4005 Garrison Boulevard, which proposes to permit, under certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking open – off street area on the property referenced in the legislation.

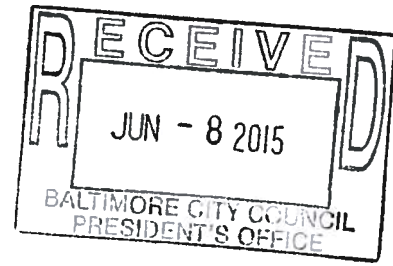
We have reviewed this proposed legislation and have determined that this bill’s passage would not have a negative impact on our transportation network. Moreover, we expect the City of Baltimore Zoning Commission to require the owners of the property to comply with parking ratios as prescribed by Code in addition to meeting all applicable guidelines associated with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) regarding the need for handicapped parking.
