17	Department of General Services shall proceed to condemn and open a 3-foot alley and a 4-foot
18	alley in the area bounded by West 29 th Street, Fox Street, West 28 th Street, and Huntingdon
19	Avenue, and more particularly described as follows:
20	Beginning for Parcel Number 1 at a point on the southwest side of West 29th
21	Street 66 feet wide, located Northeasterly at a distance of 81.00 feet from a point
22	formed by the intersection of the southeast side of said West 29 th Street and the
23	southeast side of Huntingdon Avenue 100 feet wide, binding on the southeast side
24	of West 29 th Street, the beginning of the second line in a deed dated November 6,
25 26	2007 and recorded in the Baltimore City Land Records in Liber FMC 10411,
