  Lanvale Street, Barclay Street, and Greenmount Avenue, as shown on Plat 202-A-61 in the
  Office of the Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.

#### 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the

- 16 Department of General Services shall proceed to condemn and open 2 10-foot alleys between
- Lafayette Avenue, Lanvale Street, Barclay Street, and Greenmount Avenue, and more
   particularly described as follows:
- Beginning for Parcel 2 at the point formed by the intersection of the south side of a 10-foot alley, running parallel with Lafayette Avenue 66 feet wide, and the west side of another 10-foot alley lying in the rear of the properties known as 1701 through 1723 Brentwood Avenue, 20 feet wide, the point of beginning being 50.00 feet from the east side of Brentwood Avenue, running thence and binding on the south side of the alley firstly mentioned,

 North 87° 08' 43" East 10.00 feet to the east side of the 10-foot alley secondly mentioned herein, thence binding on the alley

25 26 27 28 29	<b>SECTION 2.</b> AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the proceedings for the condemnation and opening of the alleys and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by and in accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable rules and regulations adopted by the Director of General Services and filed with the Department of Legislative Reference.

30 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 31 enacted.
