Re: City Council Bill 15-0527- Food Service Facilities-Public Notice of Suspension,
Revocations and Nonrenewal

Dear President and City Council Members:

The Mayor's Office of Information Technology has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0527 to determine technological capabilities required for proper publication of suspension, revocation and nonrenewal notices. The bill requires food service facilities to conspicuously post suspension, revocations and nonrenewal notices so that they are visible to and can be read by passing pedestrians. The notice must be placed on a form provided by the Health Commissioner and state the term and reasons for suspension. It would also mandate the Health Commissioner to include notice of suspensions, revocations and nonrenewal on its website and provide timely notice of suspensions through social media outlets.

MOIT is able to provide technological support by ensuring that all on-line forms are easily accessible, maintained securely and confidentially, and that all notices of suspensions, revocations and non-renewals are housed securely as well.

MOIT, as needed, may be able to provide user support to the Health Commissioner's Office to ensure that all users and reviewers of these on-line forms are able to access them when needed and that the Office's website is maintained and supported appropriately.
