Re: City Council Bill 15-0535 – City Streets – Closing – Worcester Street

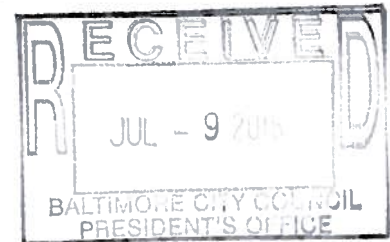
Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0535 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would allow the City to condemn and close Worcester Street, extending from CSX Transportation Railroad Right-of-Way southeasterly 301.6 feet toward Ridgely Street. The bill also provides for a special effective date.

Section (34)(a) of Article II of the City Charter grants the Mayor and City Council the power to close streets. Therefore, the Law Department approves this bill for form and legal sufficiency.
