> City Council Bill 15-0497 – Urban Renewal – Jonestown – Amendment Re:

Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0497 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would amend the Urban Renewal Plan for Jonestown Area to add a new disposition lot to the Renewal Plan, to revise Exhibit 1 to reflect a land use change in a portion of the new disposition lot, and to revise Exhibit 3 to reflect the addition of the new disposition lot. The bill's effective date is the date of enactment.

Article 13, Sections 2-6(g)(1) and (2) of the City Code require that any change to an Urban Renewal Plan be made by ordinance and be adopted and approved in the same manner as that required for the adoption and approval of a new Renewal Plan. As this bill is the appropriate mechanism for making changes to the Plan and there are no legal impediments to those changes, the Law Department approves the bill for form and legal sufficiency.
