11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in

12 accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either

13 public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in a certain

parcel of land located in Block 6840 adjacent to Lot 1/22 that is part of the former bed of Cardiff

- 15 Avenue, and more particularly described as follows:
- Beginning at a point 145' 10" due east from the intersection formed by the east side of Ponca Street and the north side of the former bed of Cardiff Avenue and
- 18 continuing east on the north side of the former bed of Cardiff Avenue for a
- 19 distance of 50', thence south a distance of 70' to intersect with the south side of the
- 20 former bed of Cardiff Avenue, then running westerly binding on the south side of
- 21 Cardiff Avenue for a distance of 50' and then northerly $\frac{50'}{70'}$ to the point of
- 22 beginning.
