15	Recitals
16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the General Fund CSX
17	Settlement Revenue in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining
18	the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2016.
19	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
20	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2016 was formulated.
21	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
22	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2016 was formulated or is for a new program that could
23	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
24	On December 9, 2015, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
25	Council.

## Council Bill 15-0604

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$1,165,000 shall be made available to the Mayor's Office of Human Services – Service 895
(Temporary Housing for the Homeless) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating
Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2016, to provide funding to maintain the Baltimore Station
overflow shelter for 125 men and to establish a low barrier shelter where individuals can receive
services while being with their partners and pets and while working on their health challenges.
The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from the General Fund CSX Settlement
Revenue in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in
determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2016.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
