18	2642 McElderry Street, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in
19	accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 3-305(b)(3) 3-305(b) and 14-102, subject to the
20	condition that the building complies with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and
21	certification requirements.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
