Recitals

- 14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from General Fund CSX
- 15 Settlement Revenue in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining 16 the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2016.
- 17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of 18 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2016 was formulated.
- 19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the 20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2016 was formulated or is for a new program that could
- 21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
- On February 3, 2016, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the CityCouncil.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 1 2 \$1,652,000 shall be made available to the Mayor's Office of Human Services – Service 895 (Temporary Housing for the Homeless) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating 3 Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2016, to provide funding for the following: (1) Men's Overflow 4 5 Shelter (\$800,000); (2) Low-Barrier Shelter (\$252,000); (3) Code Blue Shelter (\$500,000); (4) Vouchers (\$100,000). The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from General Fund 6 CSX Settlement Revenue in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the 7 8 Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 9 2016.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 11 enacted.
