

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 16-0285R introduced by Councilmembers Henry, Costello, Middleton, Stokes, Scott, Clarke, President Young, Councilmembers, Mosby, Curran, Holton, Reisinger, Branch, Welch, Kraft, and Spector.

The purpose of this bill is to request representatives from the many City agencies involved in the response to the 2016 historic blizzard to appear before the City Council to review lessons learned from this crisis and to explore what best practices should guide the City's response to future storms of this magnitude.

The Parking Authority continues to support the City's Snow Emergency Plan. We kept neighborhood garages opened during the historic blizzard and allowed residents to park free of charge while streets were being cleared of snow. Moving these vehicles assisted in the clearance of emergency routes and facilitated the delivery of services to the citizens of Baltimore City.
