City Council Bill 15-0602 -, Zoning – Conditional Use Parking, Open Re:

Off-Street Area – 1500 Fleet Street and 515-531 South Caroline Street

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0602 for the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open offstreet area on the properties known as 1500 Fleet Street and 515-531 South Caroline Street.

If enacted, this bill, along with the companion City Council Bill, 15-0601, would create parking areas on Fleet Street and South Caroline Street to accommodate displaced vehicles as a result of the expansion and modernization of H&S Bakery. The vehicles are being displaced from an existing lot at 609-611 South Caroline Street. H&S Bakery has been a stable business in the Fells Point Community for over 50 years.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 15-0602.
