11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in 12 accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either 13 public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property 14 known as 225 North Franklintown Road (Block 2215, Lot 001), and more particularly described 15 as follows:

- 16 The subject parcel (Block 2215, Lot 001) is an improved warehouse that was 17 previously used by the Department of Public Works Bureau of Solid Waste as a 18 transfer station. The site is located in the "Western" neighborhood of Baltimore 19 City,
- 20 containing 1.971 acres, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance
 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
- 23 **SECTION 3.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect when it is 24 enacted.
