AN ORDINANCE concerning
Supplementary Conduit Enterprise Fund Capital Appropriation — Department of Transportation — \$20,000,000
FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Conduit Enterprise Fund Capital Appropriation in
the amount of \$20,000,000 to the Department of Transportation (Account # 9962-941002-
9563), to provide funding for additional maintenance of the conduit system; and providing for a special effective date.

Recitals
The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the rate increase for
conduit lease fees approved by the Board of Estimates on September 23, 2015, and effective
November 1, 2015, in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining
the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2016.
This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
Estimates for Fiscal Year 2016 was formulated.
This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2016 was formulated or is for a new program that could
not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
On March 16, 2016, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
Council.

## Council Bill 16-0645

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$20,000,000 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation (Account # 9962-
941002-9563) as a Supplementary Conduit Enterprise Fund Capital Appropriation for Fiscal
Year 2016, to provide funding for additional maintenance of the conduit system. The source of
revenue for this appropriation is funds from the rate increase for conduit lease fees approved by
the Board of Estimates on September 23, 2015, and effective November 1, 2015, in excess of the
amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy
required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2016.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
