13	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That:
14	(a) Permission is granted for the construction and maintenance of a portion of a building
15	located on the east side of North Schroeder Street and known as 101 North Schroeder
16	Street, the portion of the building extending into the public right-of-way of North
17	Schroeder Street, the south side of West Lexington Street, the west side of North
18	Amity Street, and the north side of West Fayette Street, subject to the conditions
19	specified in this Ordinance.
20	(b) The structure may not project into the public right-of-way more than 4 feet, as shown
21	on the structural plan entitled "Center/West 101 N. Schroeder Street, Block EF, Shee
22	S1.01S", as revised January 29, 2016.
23	(c) Except as specifically provided in this Ordinance, all ordinances, rules, and
24	regulations of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, including but not limited to
25	the requirement to obtain a right-of-entry permit, must be complied with in the
26	construction and maintenance of this structure.
