2	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
3	Sheet 58 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the B-2-2 Zoning District to
4	the B-2-3 Zoning District the property known as 320 South Highland Avenue, as outlined in red
5	on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.
6	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the
7	accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning
8	Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
9	shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
20	and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
