The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #16-0687, which is for the purpose of correcting an inadvertent omission in the statutory list of offenses by valet parking operators that are subject to various administrative sanctions and civil fines, conforming that list to the otherwise consonant list applicable to offenses by valet parking hosts; and modifying the civil fines to be imposed for various valet-parking-related offenses based on their relative severity.

This bill will make necessary technical corrections, and will add a set of fines in a variety of categories applicable to various offenses in place of the existing single penalty option. The Department of Planning does not object to City Council Bill #16-0687, and defers to the Parking Authority and the Department of Transportation.
