Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation
Subtitle 17A. Landmark List: Exteriors - 2010s

## § 17A-37. Greater Faith Baptist Church.

Greater Faith Baptist Church, 3000-3004 Huntingdon Avenue.
SECTION 2. And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the $30^{\text {th }}$ day after the date it is enacted.
