Re: City Council Bill 16-0702 – Federal Grant Fund Operating Appropriation Transfer - Department of Housing and Community Development (Service 593 - Community Support Projects) to M-R: Educational Grants (Service 446 - Educational Grants) - \$500,000


Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 16-0702 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill transfers a Federal Grant Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$500,000 from the Department of Housing and Community Development (Service 593 - Community Support Projects) to M-R: Educational Grants (Service 446 - Educational Grants), to redirect CDGB Grant funding to increase the funding for out of school time programs. The bill provides for an immediate effective date.

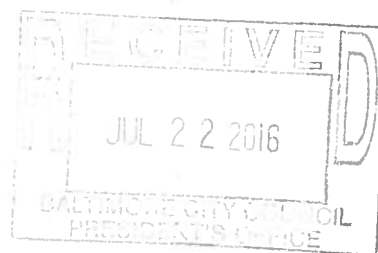
The City Charter establishes the process for transferring an appropriation in the Ordinance of Estimates from one program to another. City Charter, Art. VI, §9. The City Charter permits transfers from one agency to another, as is proposed by Council Bill 16-0702, when a transfer is recommended by the Board of Estimates and approved by ordinance of the Mayor and City Council. City Charter, Art. VI, §9(a)(2). Certain bill reports would be required if the transferred funds are for a capital expenditure, but there are no capital expenditures contemplated in this transfer. *Id.*

In conformance with the City Charter, the bill states that the Board of Estimates approved the transfers on July 13, 2016. Since this bill is the appropriate mechanism to effectuate the transfers, the Law Department approves the bill as drafted for form and legal sufficiency.
