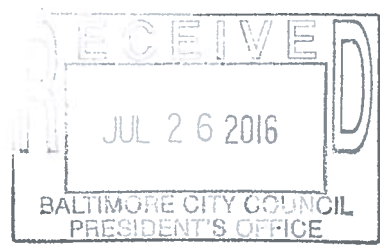

With respect to Bill #16-0669: "AN ORDINANCE concerning Port Covington Development District FOR the purpose of designating a "development district" to be known as the "Port Covington Development District"; providing for and determining various matters in connection with the establishment of the development district;...", the Baltimore City Recreation & Parks Department supports the legislation #16-0669, establishing the Port Covington Development District, with the understanding that the dedication and development of public parks, plazas and multi-use recreational trails are important components of public "infrastructure" and will be important quality of life, environmental and economic contributors to the success of the "Project".
