12 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That Sheet 55 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the B-4-1 Zoning District to 13 the B-4-2 Zoning District the property known as 325 West Baltimore Street, as outlined in blue 14

15 on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 16 17 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 18 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 19 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 20 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 21 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 22 23 the Zoning Administrator.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day 24 after the date it is enacted. 25
