1	Street Encroachment – 101 North Schroeder Street
2	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the construction and maintenance of
3	a portion of a building projecting into the public right-of-way on the east side of North
4	Schroeder Street, the south side of West Lexington Street, the west side of North Amity
5	Street, and the north side of West Fayette Street of the property known as 101 North
6	Schroeder Street; and providing for a special effective date.

12	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That:
13	(a) Permission is granted for the construction and maintenance of a portion of a building
14	located on the east side of North Schroeder Street and known as 101 North Schroeder
15	Street, the portion of the building extending into the public right-of-way of North
16	Schroeder Street, the south side of West Lexington Street, the west side of North
17	Amity Street, and the north side of West Fayette Street, subject to the conditions
18	specified in this Ordinance.
19	(b) The structure may not project into the public right-of-way more than 4 feet, as shown
20	on the structural plan entitled "Center/West 101 N. Schroeder Street, Block EF, Sheet
21	S1.01S", as revised January 29, 2016.
22	(c) Except as specifically provided in this Ordinance, all ordinances, rules, and
23	regulations of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, including but not limited to
24	the requirement to obtain a right-of-entry permit, must be complied with in the
25	construction and maintenance of this structure.
