Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland Energy Administration through EmPOWER Maryland Combined Heat and Power (CHP) in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2017.

That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2017 was formulated.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 3 4 \$1,457,640 shall be made available to the Department of Public Works – Service 730 (Public and Private Energy Performance) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal 5 Year 2017, to provide funding for 2 Combined Heat and Power (CHP) systems for the Patapsco 6 Waste Water Treatment Plant and the Back River Waste Water Treatment Plant, as well as to 7 provide funding for energy efficient upgrades at the following properties: Brooklyn Branch 8 9 Library, Callow Hill Aquatics Center, Carroll F. Cook Recreation Center, City of Baltimore 10 Health Clinic, Clifton Library, Druid Hill Family Center, Dunbar Day Care Center, Edgewood Day Care Center, Herring Run Library, Northwood Library, Patterson Park Library, Reisterstown 11 Road Library, Roosevelt Recreation Center, Sarah's Hope Homeless Shelter, Southeast Anchor 12 13 Library, Waxter Senior Center, and the Westside Youth Opportunity Center. The source of revenue for this appropriation is the grant from the Maryland Energy Administration through 14 EmPOWER Maryland Combined Heat and Power (CHP) in excess of the amount from this 15 16 source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2017. 17
