Re: City Council Bill 16-0741 - City Streets - Opening - A Portion of

**Creek Alley** 

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 16-0741, for the purpose of condemning and opening a portion of Creek Alley, extending from W. West Street southeasterly 56 feet to the southernmost extremity thereof, as shown on Plat 257-A-40 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill, a companion bill to City Council Bill 16-0742 (City Streets – Closing – A Portion of Creek Alley), would facilitate the closing of a portion of Creek Alley to support the development of a mixed-use project in the Sharp-Leadenhall community.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 16-0741.
