I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 16-0757 Planned Unit Development – Designation – North wood Commons for the purpose of repealing the existing Development Plan for the Loch Raven Boulevard and Argonne Drive Planned Unit Development, and approving a new Development Plan for the property, to be known as Northwood Commons Planned Unit Development.

The Planned Unit Development (PUD) for Loch Raven Boulevard and Argonne Drive consists of approximately 10.82 acres. As proposed, City Council Bill 16-0757, would repeal the existing PUD plan to facilitate redevelopment of the existing shopping center into a mixed-use development that will provide retail, policing services and student housing.
