AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 Planned Unit Development – Amending Ordinance 16-487 2 FOR the purpose of amending Ordinance 16-487, which repealed the existing Development Plan 3 for the Canton Crossing Planned Unit Development and approved a new Development Plan 4 for the Canton Crossing Planned Unit Development, to conform the dates of certain exhibit 5 sheets to the dates of the exhibit sheets that were signed by the Mayor and attached to and 6 made part of the Ordinance; and providing for a special effective date. 7 By repealing and reordaining with amendments Ordinance 16-487 8 9 Section(s) 3 10 Recitals Council Bill 16-0633 {Ordinance 16-487} and the exhibit sheets dated May 11 11, 2016, which were attached to and made part of the Ordinance, were signed 12 into law by the Mayor. It was subsequently discovered that the date for 3 of the 13 exhibit sheets had not been amended in the text of the Ordinance, although that 14 had been the intention of the City Council's Land Use and Transportation 15 Committee. This Ordinance is needed to amend the dates of the 3 exhibit sheets 16 to conform to what was originally intended and to what was signed into law by the 17 18 Mayor. SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 19 20 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows: 21 Ordinance 16-487 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Mayor and City 22 23 Council of Baltimore approves the replacement of the Planned Unit Development and approves the new Development Plan submitted by the 24 25 Applicant, as attached to and made part of this Ordinance, including:
