## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

2	Zoning – Conditional Use Second-Hand Store – 4418 Edmondson Avenue
3	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a second-hand store on the property known as 4418 Edmondson Avenue, as
5	outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
12	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a second-hand store
13	on the property known as 4418 Edmondson Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying
14 15	this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-309(12a) and 14-102, subject to the condition that the following conditions:
16	1. Sidewalk sales or other activities that would create clutter on the sidewalk in front of
17	the business are prohibited.
18	2. There may be no accumulation of materials, such as mattresses, discarded furniture,
19	or other trash, outside the dumpsters behind the store.
20	3. Business hours are between 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., Sunday through Saturday.
21	4. Donation items may not be accepted by the store.
22	5. Consignment items may not be accepted by the store.

**EXPLANATION:** CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. Underlining indicates matter added to the bill by amendment. Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

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1	6. Sales of any type of food or drink are prohibited.
2 3	7. The second-hand store complies must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
