Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That, in accordance with Article II, § 15(c) of the City Charter, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as $9071 / 2$ North Fremont Avenue (Block 0372, Lot 020A), and more particularly described as follows:

The subject property is an unimproved lot,
containing 0.150 acres or 6,534 square feet, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.

SECTION 2. AND be it further ordained, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.

SECTION 3. AND be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
