City Streets – Closing – Bed of Duker Alley

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) has been asked to comment on City Council Bill No. 17-0022 for the purpose of condemning and closing the bed of Duker Alley, extending westerly 92 feet, more or less, to the westernmost extremity thereof from the west side of Albemarle Street.

The condemning and closing of the bed of Duker Alley will support a proposed mixed-use development project at 800 Fleet Street, which consist of a 380-unit luxury apartment tower with 8,000 square feet of ground floor retail and a parking garage.
