Re: City Council Bill 17-0075 - Zoning – Legislative Authorizations –

Corrective

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0075, for the purpose of deleting a Council-hearing deadline that fails to account for the required procedures and time-frames for seeking and obtaining preliminary agency reviews and reports to the Council; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to Council procedures for bills proposing legislative authorizations.

If enacted, this bill would delete the requirement in Article 32 – Zoning §5-507(a)(1) for a public city council hearing to be scheduled within 90 days of introduction of a bill. Scheduling a hearing within 90 days of introduction is not always possible because of scheduling challenges due to the requirement to have a bill heard by the Planning Commission prior to the hearing and the requirement that all scheduled hearings must be announced at a City Council meeting.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 17-0075.
