FOR the purpose of designating the Harry O. Wilson House, 4423 Craddock Avenue and Block
5191, Lot 009, as an historical landmark: exterior.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation
Section(s) 17A-44

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 17A. Landmark List: Exteriors – 2010s

§ 17A-44. HARRY O. WILSON HOUSE.

HARRY O. WILSON HOUSE, 4423 CRADDOCK AVENUE AND BLOCK 5191, LOT 009.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
after the date it is enacted.
