- The right-of-way hereinafter described is no longer needed for public use, as the 17 public utility that had previously been located there has been abandoned and/or 18 relocated to another right-of-way that was granted to the Mayor and City Council 19 of Baltimore. 20
- SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 21 Comptroller of Baltimore City is hereby authorized on behalf of the Mayor and City Council of 22 Baltimore to execute and deliver to the owner or owners of the land, within the right-of-way, a 23 release and surrender of all of the interest of the City of Baltimore in the right-of-way described 24 as follows: 25
- Beginning for an 18-foot right-of-way to be released at the point designated "104" 26 as shown on the Final Subdivision Plan entitled "Memorial; Apartments" and 27 recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore City, Maryland as Plat FMC 28 29 4159, the point also being on the northwest side of Jordan Street, 18 feet wide,
