## City Streets – Opening – 8-Foot Alley Extending from the East Side of North Schroeder Street

- FOR the purpose of condemning and opening an 8-foot alley, extending easterly 76.5 feet, more
  or less, from the east side of North Schroeder Street to the east side of a 4-foot alley, as
  shown on Plat 329-A-24 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for
  a special effective date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
 Department of Transportation shall proceed to condemn and open an 8-foot alley, extending
 easterly 76.5 feet, more or less, from the east side of North Schroeder Street to the east side of a
 4-foot alley, and more particularly described as follows:

20 Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the east side of North Schroeder Street 66 feet wide, and the north side of an 8-foot alley, the 21 point of beginning being distant Southerly 70.5 feet measured along the east side 22 of North Schroeder Street from the south side of West Fairmount Avenue varying 23 in width; running thence leaving the east side of North Schroeder Street and 24 25 binding on the north side of the 8-foot alley Easterly 76.5 feet, more or less, to 26 intersect the east side of a 4-foot alley; thence binding on the east side of the 4foot alley Southerly 8 feet, more or less, to the south side of the 8-foot alley; 27 thence binding on the south side of the 8-foot alley Westerly 76.5 feet, more or 28 less, to intersect the east side of North Schroeder Street; and thence binding on the 29

- east side of North Schroeder Street Northerly 8 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.
   Containing 612 square feet or 0.014 acres, more or less.
   As delineated on Plat 329-A-24, prepared by the Survey Section and filed on July 12, 2017, in the Office of the Department of Transportation.
