City Council Bill #17-0131 was created for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain property known as the former bed of Towanda Avenue, as well as a parcel of land known as a portion of the former bed of Suffolk Avenue; these properties are no longer needed for public use.

The first property is described as the former bed of Towanda Avenue, extending from Druid Park Drive Northeasterly 537 feet to Suffolk Avenue. The second property is described as the former bed of Suffolk Avenue, extending from Towanda Avenue northeasterly 210 feet. Combined, these parcels contain 42,462 square feet.

Since these properties are no longer needed for public use, and there were no objections from various city agencies to declare the property as surplus, and since there is not a significant fiscal impact, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 17-0131.
