AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**Baltimore City Landmark List: Exteriors –
Chick Webb Memorial Recreation Center**

FOR the purpose of designating the Chick Webb Memorial Recreation Center, 1401 East Monument Street, historically known as 623 North Eden Street, as an historical landmark: exterior.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation
Section(s) 17A-44
Baltimore City Code
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 17A. Landmark List: Exteriors – 2010s

§ 17A-44. CHICK WEBB MEMORIAL RECREATION CENTER.

CHICK WEBB MEMORIAL RECREATION CENTER, 1401 EAST MONUMENT STREET,
HISTORICALLY KNOWN AS 623 NORTH EDEN STREET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
