Re: **City Council Bill 17-0138 - City Streets – Closing – A 10-Foot Alley Extending from the North Side of Esther Place**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0138, for the purpose of condemning and closing a 10-foot alley extending from the north side of Esther Place 170 feet, more or less, to the south side of East Fayette Street, as shown on Plat 276-A-25A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill would close a 10-foot alley that is no longer needed in the Patterson Park Neighborhood.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the passage of City Council Bill 17-0138.

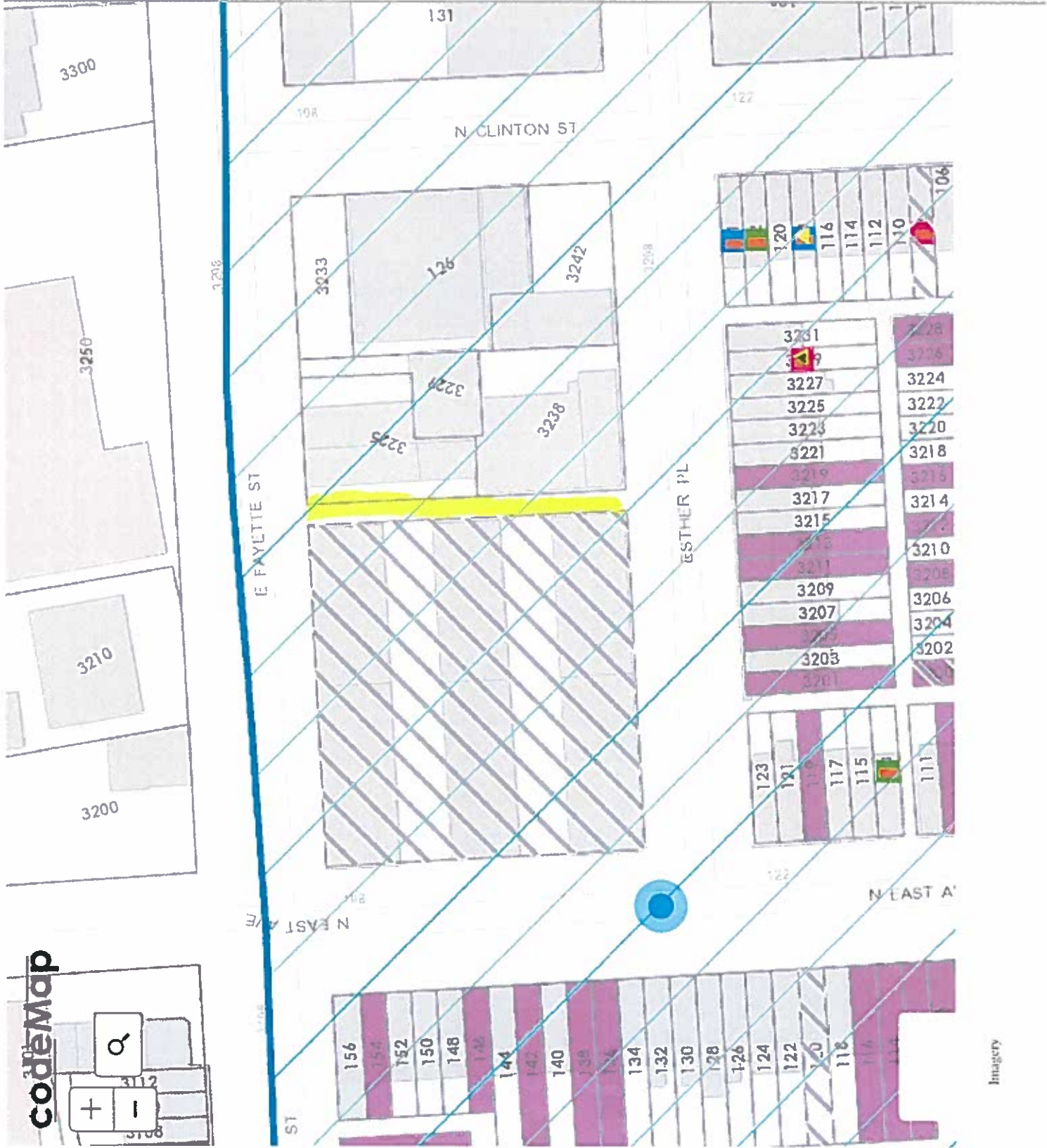
