Re: **City Council Bill 17-0139 - City Streets – Closing – North Arch Street, Vine Street, and Rieman Court**

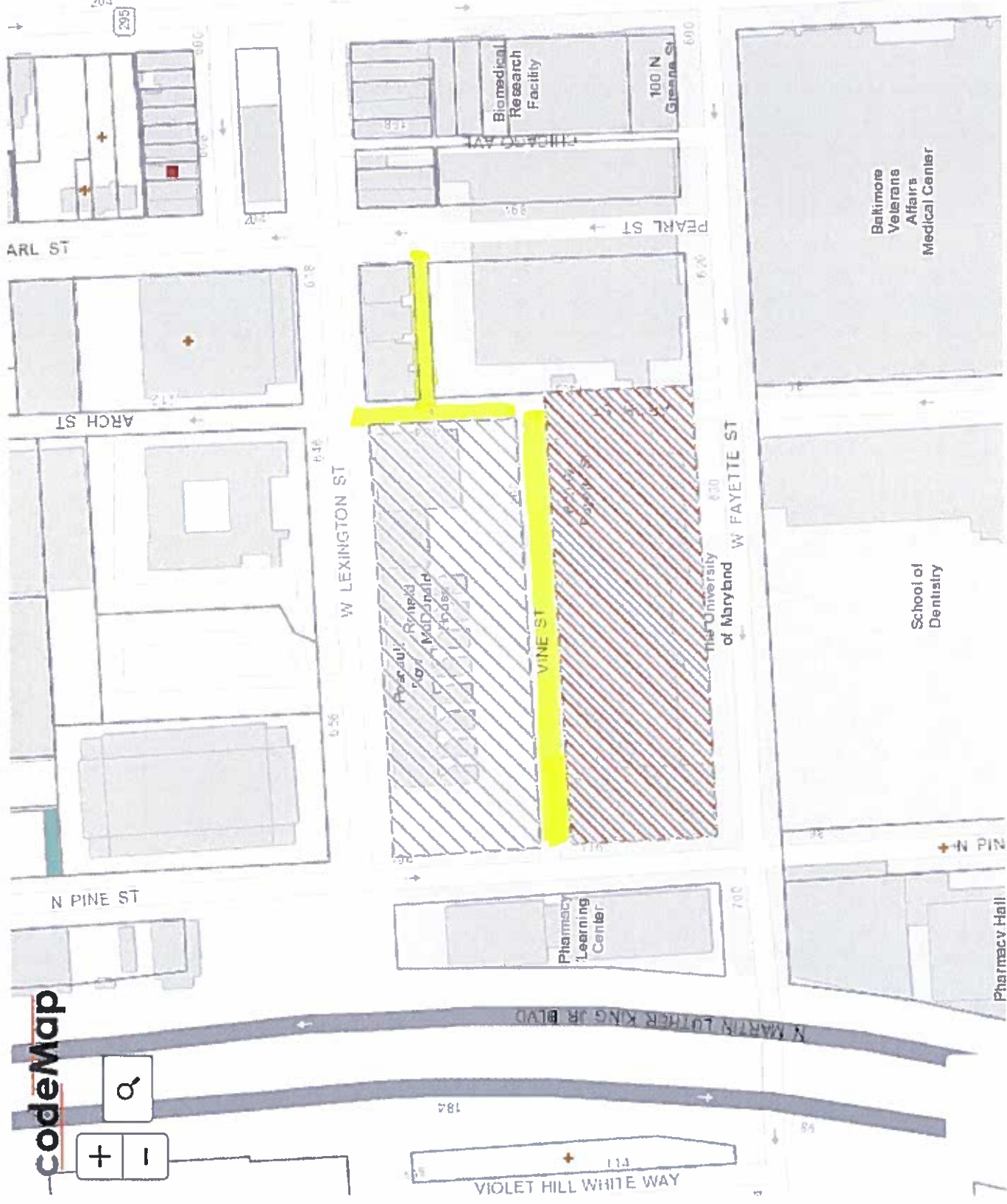
The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0139, for the purpose of condemning and closing North Arch Street, extending from West Lexington Street southerly 183 feet to the south side of Vine Street; Vine Street, extending from Pine Street easterly 441.93 feet, to the west side of North Arch Street; and Rieman Court, extending from North Arch Street easterly 138.83 feet, more or less, to the west side of North Pearl Street, as shown on Plat 345-A-19A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill would close streets that are no longer needed around properties owned by the University of Maryland.
