AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**Repeal of Ordinance 11-571 –
The District at Canton Crossing Planned Unit Development**

FOR the purpose of repealing Ordinance 11-571, as amended by Ordinances 12-13 and 12-86,
which designated certain properties as a Business Planned Unit Development known as The
District at Canton Crossing; and providing for a special effective date.

BY repealing
Ordinance 11-571, as amended by Ordinances 12-13 and 12-86

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
Ordinance 11-571, as amended by Ordinances 12-13 and 12-86, is repealed, and the authority
conferred in that Ordinance to designate certain properties as a Business Planned Unit
Development known as The District at Canton Crossing is rescinded.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect when it is
enacted.
