31 32	THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF EVENTS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE 50% DISCOUNT REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION:
33	(1) PUB CRAWLS; AND
34	(2) ROAD RACES.

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1	§ 37-2. FEES INELIGIBLE FOR DISCOUNT.
2	The $50\%$ discount required by this subtitle does not apply to:
3	(1) THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PARKS FEE SCHEDULE; OR
4	(2) FEES IMPOSED BY THE PARKING AUTHORITY;
5 6 7	(3) FEES CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR TEMPORARY STRUCTURES PURSUANT TO BUILDING CODE § 109.6.1.m {"TEMPORARY STRUCTURES"}; OR
8	(4) FEES CHARGED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.
9	§ 37-3. RULES AND REGULATIONS.
10	(A) IN GENERAL.
11 12	THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.
13	(B) COPIES TO BE FILED WITH LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE.
14 15	A COPY OF ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION MUST BE FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BEFORE THEY BECOME EFFECTIVE.
16 17 18	<b>SECTION 2.</b> AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the  $30^{\text{th}} \underline{60^{\text{th}}}$ 20 day after the date it is enacted.
