City Streets – Opening – North Arch Street, a Portion of Vine Street, and a Portion of Rieman Court

- FOR the purpose of condemning and opening North Arch Street, extending from West Lexington
 Street Southerly 183 feet to the south side of Vine Street, a portion of Vine Street, extending
 from Pine Street Easterly 441.93 feet to North Arch Street, and a portion of Rieman Court,
 extending from North Arch Street Easterly 101 feet, more or less, as shown on Plat 345-A-19

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 17 Department of Transportation shall proceed to condemn and open North Arch Street, extending 18 from West Lexington Street Southerly 183 feet to the south side of Vine Street, a portion of Vine 19 Street, extending from Pine Street Easterly 441.93 feet to North Arch Street, and a portion of 20 Rieman Court, extending from North Arch Street Easterly 101 feet, more or less, and more 21 particularly described as follows:

Beginning for Parcel 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the south side of Vine Street 43 feet wide, and the east side of Pine Street 50 feet wide, the point of beginning being distant Northerly 150 feet, measured along the east side of Pine Street from the north side of West Fayette Street 66 feet wide; thence binding on the east side of Pine Street northerly 32.75 feet to a point on the north side of the parcel; thence binding on the north side of the parcel Easterly 441.93 feet to intersect the west side of North Arch Street 24 feet wide; thence binding on the

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- west side of North Arch Street Southerly 32.42 feet to intersect the south side of 1 2 Vine Street and thence binding on the south side of Vine Street Westerly 441.93 3 feet to the place of beginning. 4 Containing 14,400 square feet or 0.3305 acre, more or less. 5 Beginning for Parcel 2 at the point formed by the intersection of the south side of 6 Vine Street 43 feet wide, so projected easterly, and the east side of North Arch 7 Street 24 feet wide, the point of beginning being distant Northerly 149.9 feet, 8 more or less, measured along the easternmost outline of the property known as 9 630 West Fayette Street from the north side of West Fayette Street 66 feet wide; thence leaving the easternmost outline of the property and binding along the south 10 side of Vine Street, so projected easterly, Westerly 24 feet to the west side of 11 North Arch Street; thence binding on the west side of North Arch Street, 12 13 Northerly 183 feet to intersect the south side of West Lexington Street 66 feet wide: thence binding on the south side of West Lexington Street Easterly 24 feet 14 15 to the east side of North Arch Street and thence binding on the east side of North Arch Street Southerly 183 feet to the place of beginning. 16 17 Containing 4,386 square feet or 0.1007 acre, more or less. Beginning for Parcel 3 at the point formed by the intersection of the north side of 18 19 Rieman Court 16 feet wide, and the east side of North Arch Street 24 feet wide, 20 the point of beginning being distant Southerly 55 feet measured along the east side of North Arch Street from the south side of West Lexington Street 66 feet wide; 21 thence leaving the east side of North Arch Street and along the north side of 22 Rieman Court, Easterly 101 feet, more or less, to a point on the easternmost 23 extremity of the parcel; thence binding on the easternmost extremity of the parcel 24 25 Southerly 8 feet to a point on the southernmost extremity of parcel; thence binding on the southernmost extremity of the parcel Westerly 101 feet, more or less, to 26 27 intersect the east side of North Arch Street and thence binding on the east side of 28 North Arch Street Northerly 8 feet to the place of the beginning. Containing 808 square feet or 0.0185 acre, more or less. 29 30 As delineated on Plat 345-A-19, prepared by the Survey Section and filed on May 12, 2017, in the Office of the Department of Transportation. 31
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the proceedings for the condemnation and opening of the streets and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by and in accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable rules and regulations adopted by the Director of Transportation and filed with the Department of Legislative Reference.
