14	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in		
15	accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either		
16	public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in certain		
17	parcels of land known as the former bed of Water Street, extending from Grant Street easterly		
18	157.3 feet, more or less, to South Calvert Street, and the former bed of Hollingsworth Street,		
19	extending southerly 159.6 feet, more or less, to East Lombard Street, and more particularly		
20	described as follows:		
21	Beginning for Parcel 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the west side of		
22	South Calvert Street 74 feet wide, and the south side of Water Street 20 feet		
23	wide, the point of beginning being distant Northerly 160 feet, more or less,		
24	measured along the west side of South Calvert Street from East Lombard Street		
25	90 feet wide; thence leaving the west side of South Calvert Street Westerly 157.10		
26	feet, more or less, to intersect the east side of Grant Street 28 feet wide, thence		
27	binding on the east side of Grant Street Northerly 20 feet, to the north side of		
28	Water Street; thence binding on the north side of Water Street Easterly 157.3 feet,

7	feet wide, the point of beginning being distant Westerly 80.4 feet, more or less,			
8	measured along the north side of East Lombard Street from South Calvert Street			
9	74 feet wide; thence binding on the north side of East Lombard Street			
10	Southwesterly 15 feet, to the west side of Hollingsworth Street, thence binding on
