SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
 peak hour parking restrictions imposed by the Department of Transportation under Article 31,
 § 2-5 or § 2-6 are hereby terminated on the following block faces:

- 14 (1) Both sides of the 1500 block of East 33<sup>rd</sup> Street;
- 15 (2) Both sides of the 1600 block of East 33<sup>rd</sup> Street;
- 16 (3) Both sides of the 1700 block of East 33<sup>rd</sup> Street; and
- 17 (4) Both sides of the 1800 block of East  $33^{rd}$  Street.

## SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
