
I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 18-0202, introduced by Councilmembers Pinkett, Costello, and Stokes.

The purpose of this bill is to repeal Ordinance 63-1594, as amended by Ordinances 67-962, 67-1042, 70-800, and 75-1061 and by minor amendments approved by the Board of Estimates on October 19, 1966, January 17, 1973, and February 28, 1973, which established the Madison - Park North Urban Renewal Area and Plan; and providing for a special effective date.

The Madison - Park North Urban Renewal Area is located west of I-83 and south of North Ave., in the neighborhoods of Bolton Hill, Reservoir Hill, and Madison Park. The area is mostly residential with some commercial and contains several parks and schools. City Council Bill 18-0202, if approved, would repeal the Urban Renewal Area and Plan, leaving the area subject to the requirements the zoning.

The Department of Public Works defers to the Department of Planning on City Council Bill 18-0202.
